



Access and Security Policy

Hours of Access:

Access to the building will be during posted hours of operation. Hours of operation vary based on the times that on water practices are offered and can be changed without notice due to coach's schedule or racing schedule.

For members over the age of 18, access to personal boats during club programming time is permitted with the strict agreement between that member and the coach running the program. This agreement must be done in advance. If the member is late arriving back at the boathouse, past the agreed to time, the member forfeits the privilege to attend during their non-paddling time. Please note that no safety boat is provided when personal boats are utilized, and members paddle at their own risk and are expected to abide by the SNCC Code of Safety.

Authorization and Issuing of Keys:

Keys are issued to the commodore, all coaches and the Head Canoe Kids Camp Instructor. From time to time, the board of directors can permit the issuing of keys to non-coaches for purposes of maintenance or repair on boats, etc. The board must approve all of these circumstances, in advance.

It is forbidden to duplicate any club keys. Duplication of keys will result in disciplinary action by the board for the involved individuals, which could include cancellation of club membership.

Keys are not transferable between individuals. The security code is also not transferable.

The board reserves the right to terminate a key holder agreement at any time and request the immediate return of the keys.
